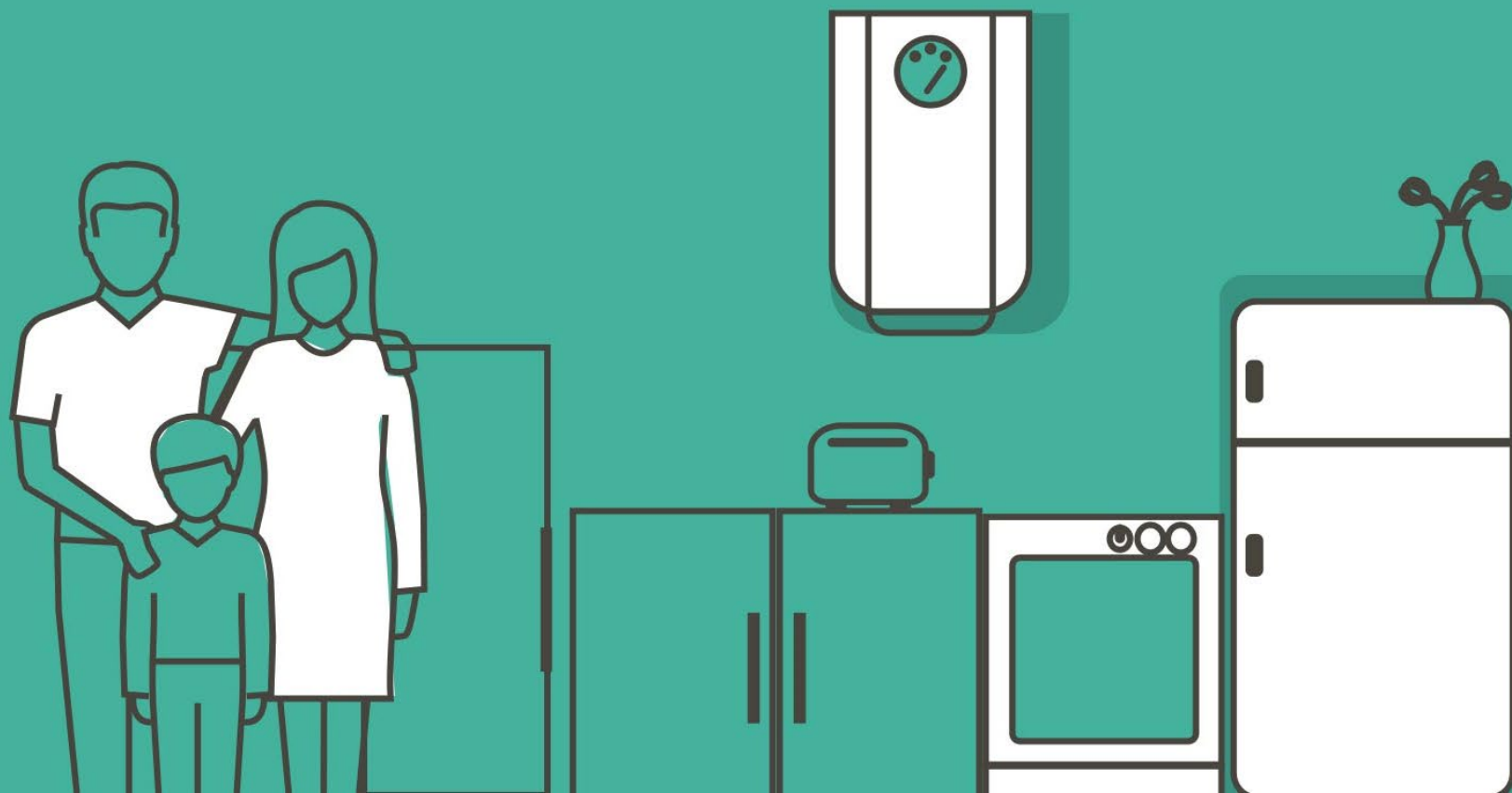

Energy Redress Scheme

- The Scheme distributes voluntary payments from Ofgem regulated companies that may have breached rules
- Funding amounts vary as new payments are received
- We review funding on a quarterly basis (Jan, Apr, Jul & Oct)
- Open to registered charities & Housing Associations (exempt charities)
- Available to organisations based in England, Scotland or Wales
- Must be registered with Energy Redress
- Priorities mainly supporting energy consumers in vulnerable situations



What can we fund?

- ✓ Capital or revenue funding
- ✓ Up to 100% of the project cost
- ✓ Projects lasting up to 24 months
- ✓ Minimum & maximum grant set for each funding stream
- ✓ Grants are paid quarterly in arrears on receipt of progress reports

**We cannot fund any activity that will benefit an Ofgem regulated company e.g.
ECO top ups, direct referrals into supplier obligations**



Redress Funds

- Round 9 closed Wednesday 4 November outcome due late December
- Round 10 likely to open in January 2021 with projects to start around April time
 - Small Fund / Main Fund / Innovation Fund
- Look out for updates as we have a **new fund** on the way!!



Crisis Fund

Fund covers cost of fuel vouchers, administration charge per voucher plus charity admin costs (max 15% voucher cost)

Round 5 Open

- Amount: £3.9 million
- Grant size: £50,000 - £400,000
- Priority: to support prepayment consumers who are disconnected or at risk of disconnection as a result of the pandemic
- Deadline: 30 November 2020 5pm



Advice to applicants

- Stand out from the crowd
- Be clear about the benefits & the difference the project will make
- What evidence do you have that this is the right approach
- Think collaboration rather than competition!
- Be concise bullet points are acceptable
- Proof read the application before submission
- Consider the impact of COVID-19 on the project
