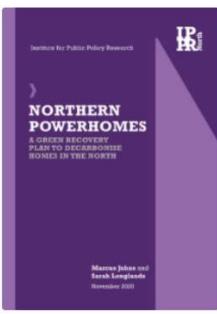
#### **#OurNorth Net Zero**

  are preferred options e.g. heat pumps, then why?
- Decisions made to last, and installations done to high standards















# Social Housing Tenants' Climate Jury: Costs of Retrofit and Managing Disruption



#### Costs of Retrofit and Managing Disruption

- Where is the funding coming from? Private, public, tenant rent?
- What about maintenance?
- Potential disruption and how this will be mitigated should be communicated upfront.



















#### **Education and Communication**

- Improve awareness of climate change
- Comprehensive communication needed
- Need to think innovatively on reaching tenants
