## KS3 – Assembly



### Session Aims:

- To discuss whether heat and electricity is a human right
- Identify the extent of Fuel poverty in England
- State what might make someone vulnerable and what the impacts may be
- Explore the cost of appliances and strategies to be more energy efficient.

### KS3 Curriculum Links:

#### English:

- learning new vocabulary, relating it explicitly to known vocabulary and understanding it

#### Maths:

- develop their use of formal mathematical knowledge to interpret and solve problems, including in financial mathematics

#### Science:

- comparing power ratings of appliances in watts (W, kW)
